Learning Resource Centers (LRCs) were established in each campus on 17 April 1997 by the UP Board of Regents. Inaugurated in 22 January 1999, the **Gerardo “Dinggoy” Roxas** Learning Center (DLRC) is currently located at the back of Kamia Residence Hall. The DLRC is open Mondays to Fridays, 8 to 12 nn and 1 to 5 pm, and readily offers its services to all UP students.

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
